Stop by today and get your forms and pedometer to start your Spring with a new step and a healthier you!



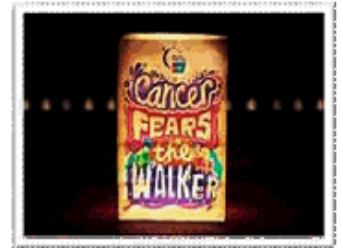


Symbols of Remembrance & Hope
